24/7 DANCE STUDIO POLICIES

- TUITION & REGISTRATION:** You are guaranteed 32 weeks of classes. Payment Installments are done by automatic withdrawal with Visa/MC and are done on the 1st business day of the month in a total of 9 equal installments. Two installment payments are due by September 1st, the first when you register and the other will be automatically be charged on September 1st. You will be charged on the 1st business day of each month through May. If a credit card is not on file, tuition is an additional \$5 per month. December is costume payment only. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed on the 15th of each month for accounts with outstanding balances. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS ON TUITION OR COSTUMES.**
- CARE OF STUDENTS:** Children 7 and under must have parental supervision in the building at all times.
- WAIVER & RELEASE:** Parents, legal guardians of minors & adult students waive the right to legal action for injury sustained on studio property. The studio is hereby granted permission and copyrights for photographs/video/social media taken of students for advertising purposes.
- ATTENDANCE:** Students are allowed to make up 3 missed classes until January 31st. Students may only miss 3 classes after February 1st to be able to be in the recital. There are no refunds for missed classes.
- COMMUNICATION:** 24/7 communicates **primarily via EMAIL**, website, Facebook, Twitter & our bulletin board. For snow closings and other emergencies we also use text through Remind. Text **@247da** to (240) 348-1783 to sign up. If you have a question for your teacher, please write a note or send an email. Please do not delay teachers between classes.
- OBSERVATION:** Color video observation of all studios is available in our lobby anytime there is a class going on. We have a scheduled Parent Observation Week in November.
- PARKING:** Please follow our traffic patterns. You may drop off at the curb (maximum 10 secs) but no picking up. No idling curbside.
- WAITING AREA & OTHER COMMON AREAS:** We provide common areas for you to wait while students are in class. These areas are **QUIET** areas so as not to disturb or interrupt classes in session. Please clean up after yourself and your children and leave all areas as you found them.
- TERMS & CONDITIONS:** Class days/times may need to be adjusted based on enrollment. If class enrollment is less than 5 students, we may move them to a comparable class and otherwise terminate the class. In the event that 3 or less students report to class, class length may be shortened 15 minutes.
- WITHDRAWAL:** A Withdrawal form must be completed and turned in to the front desk. This stops the automated withdrawals within 30 days.
- SNOW/CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY:** We do not follow the school calendars. Cancellations will be announced via website, email, Facebook, Twitter, answering machine and text and will be done by 8am/2pm. Sign up for text messages by sending **@247da** to 240-348-1783 (**text used for cancellations only**). We include "extra" days into our schedule for snow days.
- PROGRESS REPORTS:** Progress reports are done mid year and end of year. Class recommendations are included in the last progress report.
