PAYMENT PLAN

Company students will make monthly Company payments (10 total payments). The payments are charged on the 15th of each month (July-April). Delinquent payments will result in a late fee and possible disqualification from the program. All estimated costs for the year (rehearsal, choreography, costumes, 2 competitions, fall show, workshop) will be totaled and split into 10 even payments. Additional expenses/balances would be billed at a later date. Anticipated monthly installments are estimated below, based on 1 child in company (sibling rehearsal discount not noted). Studio classes, rehearsal attire, shoes/tights/etc are NOT included in this amount. Current figures based on 2018-2019 dance year. Subject to change.

COST BREAKDOWN:

REHEARSAL FEES

Rehearsal fees go towards studio space, facility maintenance, instructor compensation, etc. Also included in this total is the Choreography for a Production. This fee is set at \$60/payment for each student (\$600/year). For 2 siblings in Company, the fee is set at \$500/year for each student, and \$400/year for each student if there are 3 siblings in Company.

CHOREOGRAPHY FEES

Choreography is what makes up a dance. Fees are based on level, and go towards compensating the choreographers for their time, talent, and travel. Everyone must be in a minimum of 2 new company dances, and you may ask to be considered for up to 8 new company dances. This season we are continuing to try to make additional choreography more affordable and are using a sliding price scale.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

- Mini company – 1-2 classes:** 1 Combo OR 1 Ballet & 1 Jazz
- Youth & Junior level companies – 2-3 total classes** depending on genre
- Teen level companies – 2-4 total classes** depending on genre/level
- Senior level companies – 2-5 total classes** depending on genre
- Boys Krew – 1 class:** 1 Hip Hop

- Jazz/Contemporary companies – 2-5 total classes** depending upon level: Jazz and Ballet classes, plus 1 Contemporary class and/or 1 Turns & Leaps
 - Hip Hop companies – 2 total classes:** 1 Hip Hop class + 1 Ballet OR Jazz class
 - Tap companies – 2 total classes:** 1 Tap class + 1 Ballet OR Jazz class
 - Musical Theater dances – 2 total classes:** 1 Musical Theater/Vocal class + 1 Ballet OR Jazz class

COSTUMES

Costume payments are the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian. You will need 1 costume for each dance in which you are cast, plus Full Company Production. The average costume costs \$75 for Mini/Youth/Junior/Boys Krew levels and \$100 for Teen/Senior levels.

COMPETITION

All dances are guaranteed to compete at least one time each season, but may compete twice, at the sole discretion of the Directors. Estimate \$58 per group dance, for each competition we attend. Built into the installment plan is \$58 for each dance (for 2 competitions each), and \$62 for the Full Company Production, which will only compete once. Optional solos, duets, and trios are additional.

FALL SHOW

All company members will participate in a Fall Show. All company members will pay a Show fee (already included above), which covers choreography, theater rental, rehearsals, show staff, etc. Does not count towards # of dances.

WORKSHOPS

All company members Youth level and up will be required to attend at least one convention/workshop to which we travel (there is no in studio requirement this year). Workshops can range from \$175-270 on average, plus travel expenses. The fee for one will be included in the monthly installment plan. Boys Krew & Mini Company are not required to attend, but may opt to attend the workshop.

REHEARSAL ATTIRE

Black leotard (style is your choice) + Your Choice of Black spandex shorts and/or Caramel tights

Male dancers: Please wear form fitting all black dance attire

Appropriate footwear for all

Hair secured in a bun

Tap and Hip Hop dancers may wear your own comfortable all black dance attire. Ponytails acceptable.

SHOE REQUIRMENTS

PRIDE company members may have to purchase any or all of the following shoes, depending on genres/choreography. **DO NOT PURCHASE until confirmation from your Director.**

-Jazz boot – Capezio #EJ2 or SoDanca #JZ45 (caramel and/or black)

-Capezio caramel pedini #PP323

-Capezio Freeform jazz shoe #FF01 (caramel and/or black)

-Pink canvas split sole ballet shoe – So Danca SD16L (girls only; boys please order black)

-Capezio pirouette I canvas lyrical shoe (nude)

-T-strap Character shoe w/2” heel – choose Capezio #700, or SoDanca CH56/CH57 (caramel/black)

-Tap: Jason Samuel Smith OR So Danca TA715/815

-Hip Hop: Nike Roshe One – Black/White sole (Metallic silver swoosh for kids, Dark Grey swoosh for women’s sizes, “Anthracite” for men’s sizes)

Each student should have extra pairs of all shoes used in performance.

GRADUATING SENIOR DANCE

All company members who are graduating seniors will be a part of this dance. There is no choreography fee. You only pay for costume and competition.

24/7 SRC

All company members are required to join the SRC, which is our non-profit 501©3 company that aids in all of our fundraising. There is a \$100 membership fee. You can choose to complete the required volunteer hours (approximately 15-20 per family), or contribute \$300 towards the SRC. Most parents find that volunteering for our fundraising events is a great way to forge relationships with other parents and to help give great benefits to the children!

DISNEY TRIP

This season, we are thrilled to announce all company levels will be invited to go to Disney! This will be an **OPTIONAL** trip in November, with performance and casting based on who is able to attend. We will be performing as a company, as well as enjoying all that the parks have to offer. Estimated cost for the trip is roughly \$1300/person, for hotel, airfare, park tickets, and performance costs, plus additional costs for food and personal extras. We have a goal that the SRC will be able to help cover part of this cost for each member. Chaperones will be needed, and selected based on applications, and will also have their own trip expenses.
